**A** **Area 51:** A high-energy indoor adventure park packed with climbing and obstacle fun for all ages.

**B** **Bamboo Down Under:** A relaxed garden adventure with scavenger hunts, a bamboo maze and peaceful rainforest walks.

**C** **CSi Club Southport:** A family-friendly club with dining, playgrounds and a splash pad!

**D** **Dig It:** Let kids take the controls of real machinery and experience a hands-on construction adventure.

**E** **Eagle Tree Park, Coomera:** A colourful playground with climbing, swings and plenty of open space for kids to explore

**F** **Farm & Co, Cudgen:** A beautiful farm experience with flower fields, animals, café treats and space to slow down.

**G** **Greenheart Parklands:** An epic fenced play space with water play, a bike track and wide open green spaces.

**H** **HOPO:** Jump on the hop on, hop off ferry, offering a fun way to explore the Broadwater by water.

**I** **Ian Dipple Lagoon:** A safe, calm swimming spot perfect for little ones beside the Broadwater.

**J** **Jellural Aboriginal Cultural Centre:** An educational and meaningful experience sharing local Yugambeh culture and stories.

**K** **Kokomo Café, Coomera:** A waterside cafe with Fiji-vibes popular with families and kids in tow.

**L** **Lorikeet Park, Worongary:** see the larger-than-life Lorikeet sculpture, with an amazing climbing and adventure playground too!

**M** **Marine Discovery Centre:** An interactive space where kids can get hands on with rockpool inhabitants.

**N** **Natural Bridge, Springbrook:** An easy rainforest walk leading to a stunning rock bridge and glow worm spotting.

**O** **Outdoor Cinema:** A fun evening out at either one of Gold Coast Council's Movies Under the Stars or Yatala Drive-in Cinema

**P** **Pimpama Sports Hub:** Head to the Splash Pad, perfect for cooling off on hot Gold Coast days.

**Q** **Quota Park, Biggera Waters:** Climb the net up to the crows nest and pretend you're sailing a pirate ship on the high seas at this nautical playground.

**R** **Rockpools at Broadwater Parklands:** A favourite water play spot combining shallow pools and playground fun.

**S** **Summerland Farm:** A working macadamia farm with farm tours, café treats, animals, a splash pad and plenty of space to roam and play.

**T** **Tweed Regional Museum:** A modern museum with engaging exhibits and family-friendly displays.

**U** **Up high at SkyPoint:** Panoramic Gold Coast views from the top of the Q1 SkyPoint Observation Deck.

**V** **Views at Best of All Lookout:** Breathtaking hinterland and coastline views worth the short 10 minute rainforest walk.

**W** **Wildlife Sanctuary Byron Bay:** A small and intimate wildlife sanctuary home to many animal encounters, a playground and a splash pad.

**X** **eXhibition at HOTA Children's Gallery:** A creative, interactive children's gallery designed especially for curious young minds.

**Y** **Yatala Pies:** An iconic Gold Coast food stop famous for classic Aussie pies and road-trip vibes.

**Z** **Australia Zoo:** It's not the Gold Coast, but a full-day wildlife adventure to Australia Zoo is worth the roadtrip for every Gold Coast family!
